



Child Protection Policy 2010

Leaders of groups using The Christian Adventure Centre have responsibility for ensuring that an adequate child protection policy is in place for their group.

You are responsible for
any child protection issues within your group
the behaviour and safety of your young people at all times.

You must have a minimum leader to group ratio of 1 to 10. When bringing a mixed group there must be male and female leaders present at all times.

Please be aware that there may be other groups on site although measures are in place to avoid groups mixing.

As a Centre we will provide as safe an environment as we can for your young people. All our staff have current enhanced disclosure clearance through the Criminal Records Bureau (CRB). However, you have a duty of care for the young people you bring and must take full responsibility for them and their actions whilst they are on site.

The main leaders of your group must have a current Enhanced Disclosure Form from the CRB. This disclosure must not be more than 3 years old, and we will need to see a copy. We expect assistant leaders to have a standard disclosure, which we also need to see.
